K. Wilson outlined what the requirements were for all Federation races, yellow race rubbers, chrom check before basketing and clock-out with Clock Foreman G. Wilson, app used for setting the time "Flipclock"

The President spoke to the meeting about the 3 young bird races

Basketing procedures for Leeman 3, 21st June, Port Denison 3, 12th July and Drummond Cove 2, 25th July all of which incorporate Young Bird Races

For the main races on those dates competitors can send a maximum of 25 birds of any age.

For the young bird race on those dates competitors can send a maximum of 15 YOUNG BIRDS

Both race to be race marked separately.

Birds for both races can go in the same crates

All birds will be liberated together

At least 1 bird to be timed in each race

Federation points will be awarded for both races

The President reminded the meeting of EBSS Race Rule 18

During the basketing procedure, the bird data provided on screen by the EBSS is to be cross checked against the actual bird and life ring data on the pigeon life ring (and the basket list when printed). If the data does not correspond, the bird is to be disqualified from the race—except that in cases of sex or colour/pattern discrepancies the basketing list may be amended (as is the case with non EBSS bird nominations)

Some questions were raised on the new fee system, these were taken onboard by the Board to be addressed at the Board meeting

The President thanked everyone for their attendance
